BY REPRESENTATIVE HENRY
AN ACT**

Making annual appropriations for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 for the ordinary expenses of the executive branch of state government, pensions, public schools, public roads, public charities, and state institutions and providing with respect to the expenditure of said appropriations.

The head of each agency or department is prohibited from expending or encumbering any withholdings until February 1, and then only if there has not been a budget status report presented to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget that indicates the total appropriation from the State General Fund (Direct) for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 will exceed the forecast for that fund or a budget status report that shows a deficit for State General Fund (Direct) at the close of the previous fiscal year. The monthly budget status report submitted to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget shall include a section reporting the amounts withheld."
